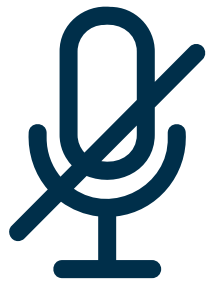

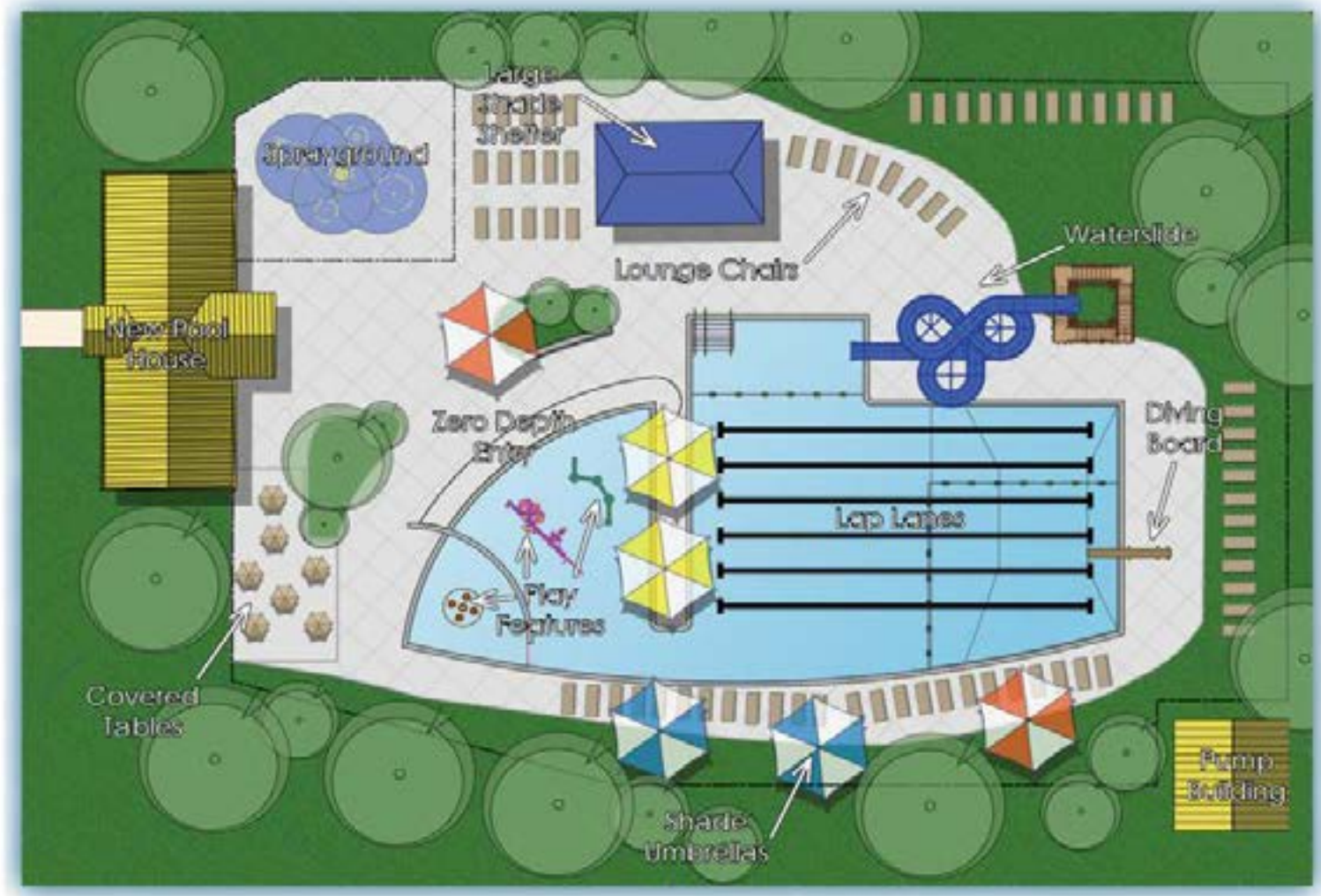
AQUATIC MASTER PLAN: COMMUNITY POOL

FEATURES

SERVICE AREA: 3 MILE, 10 MIN. DRIVE/BIKEABLE

POOL SIZE: SURFACE AREA 5,000-7,000 SF

CONSTRUCTION COST: NEW CONSTRUCTION: \$5-7 MILLION
RENOVATION: \$3-4 MILLION

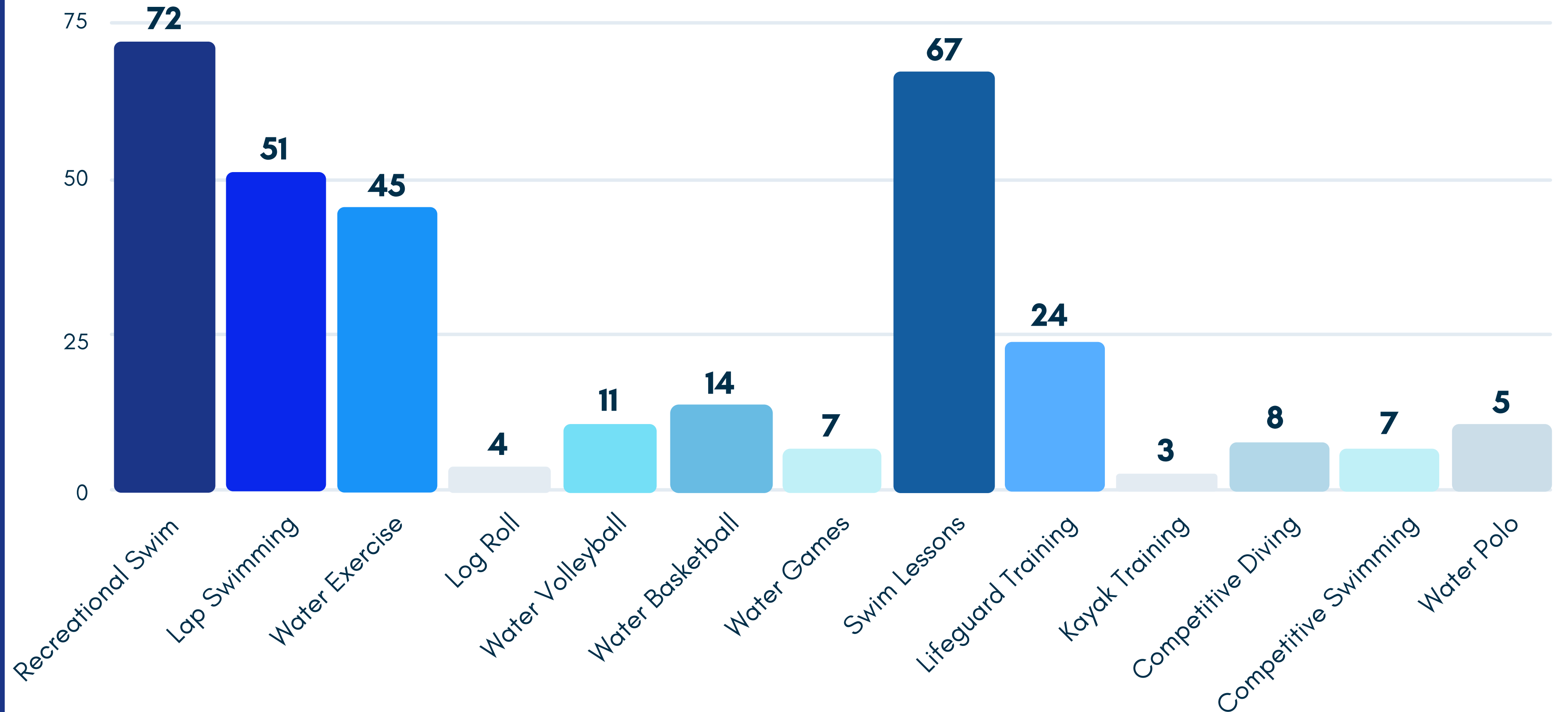

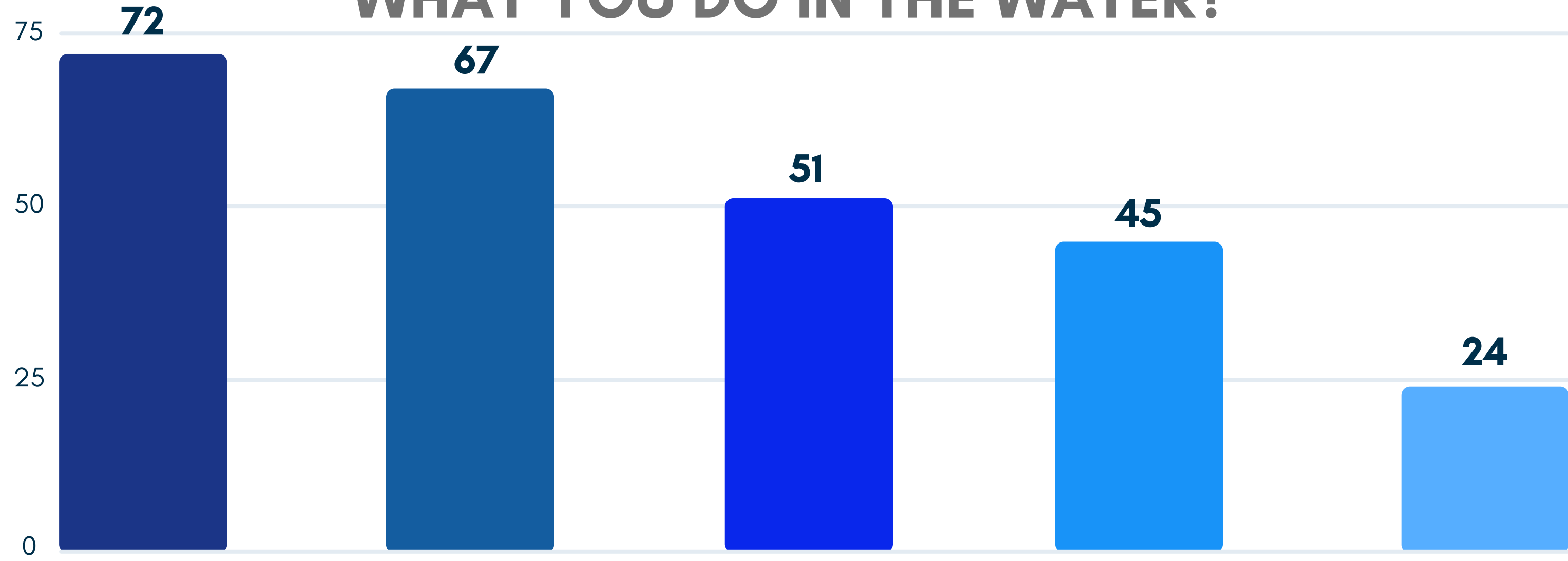

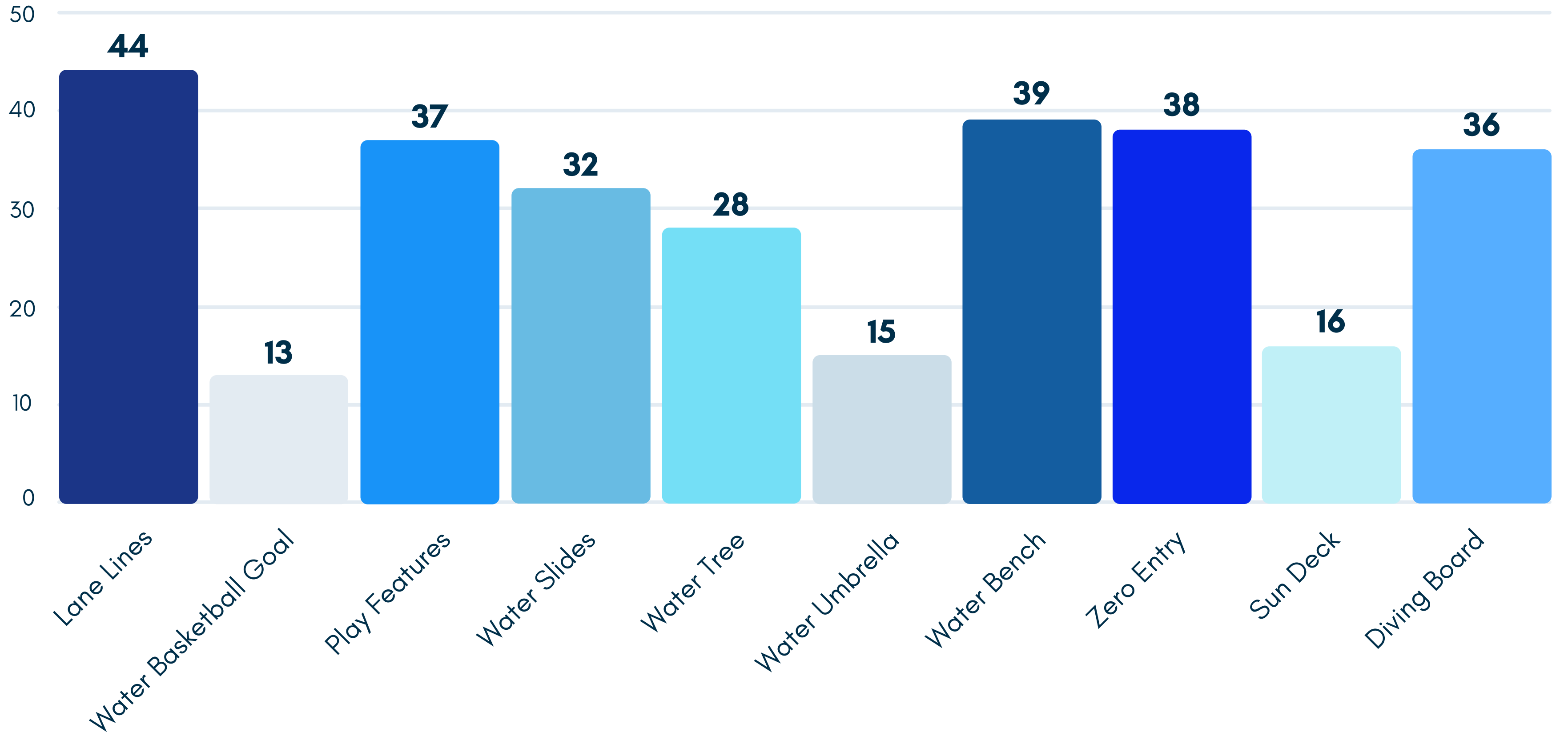

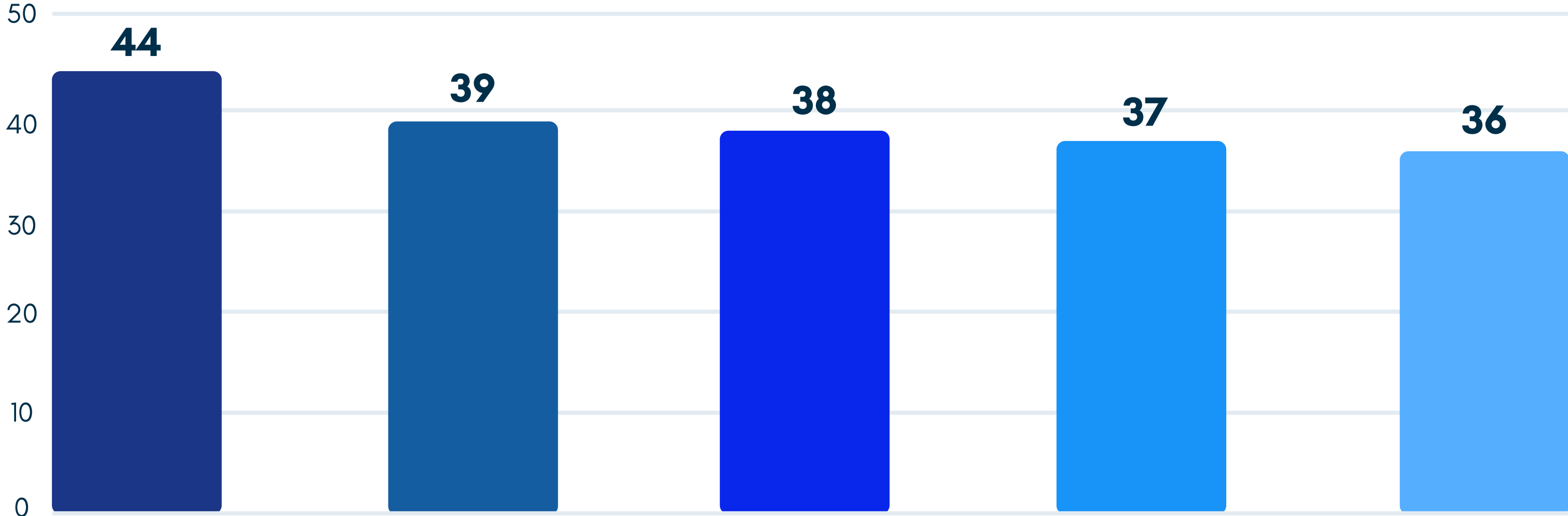

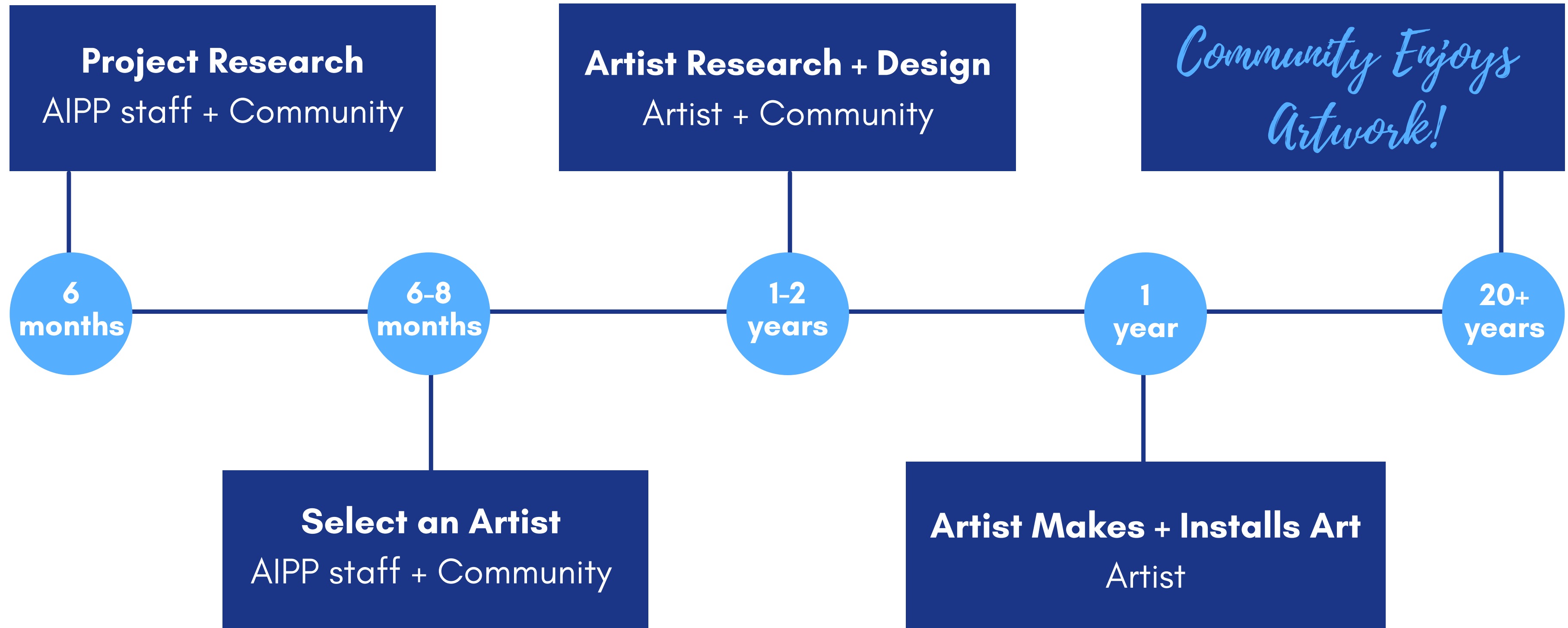

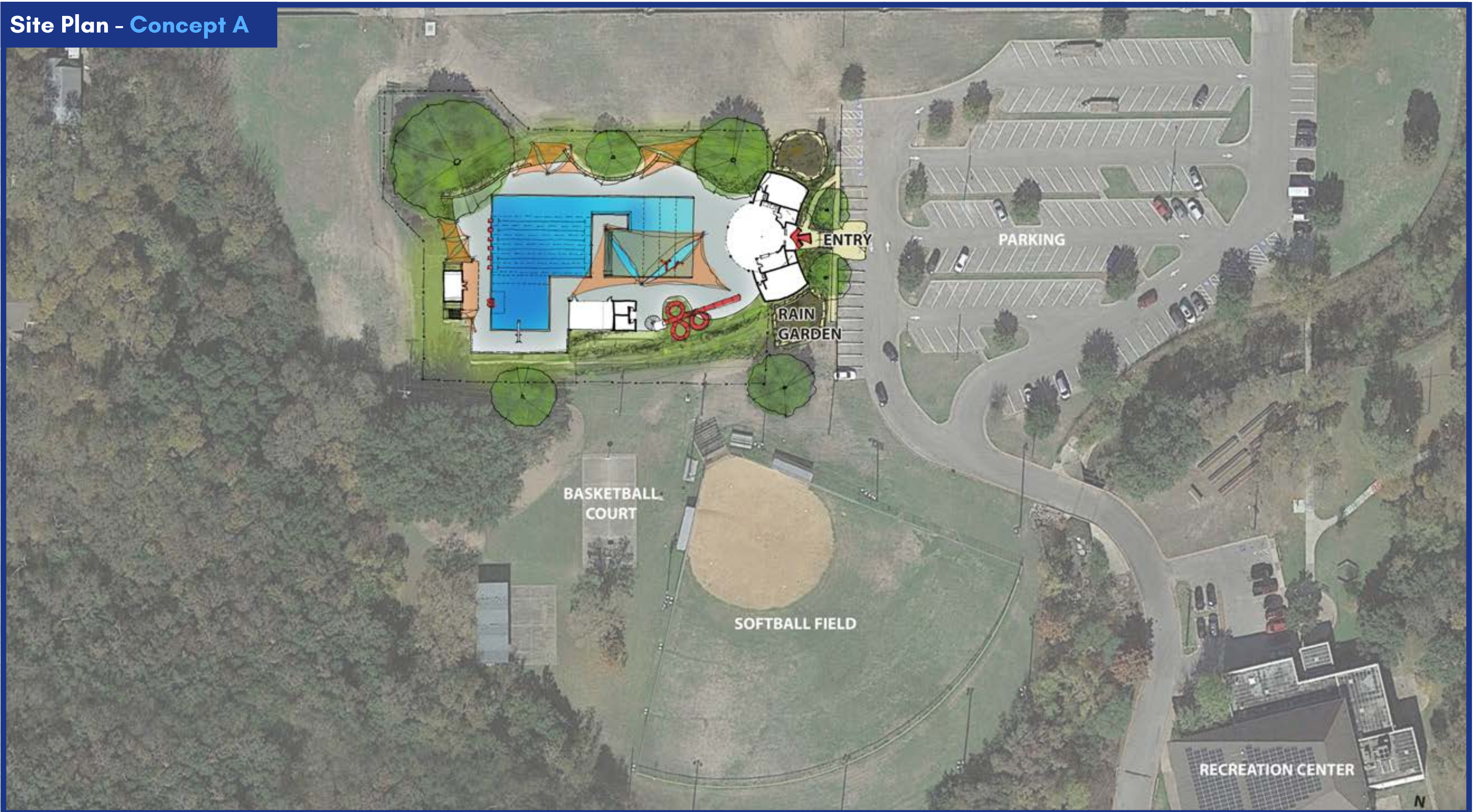

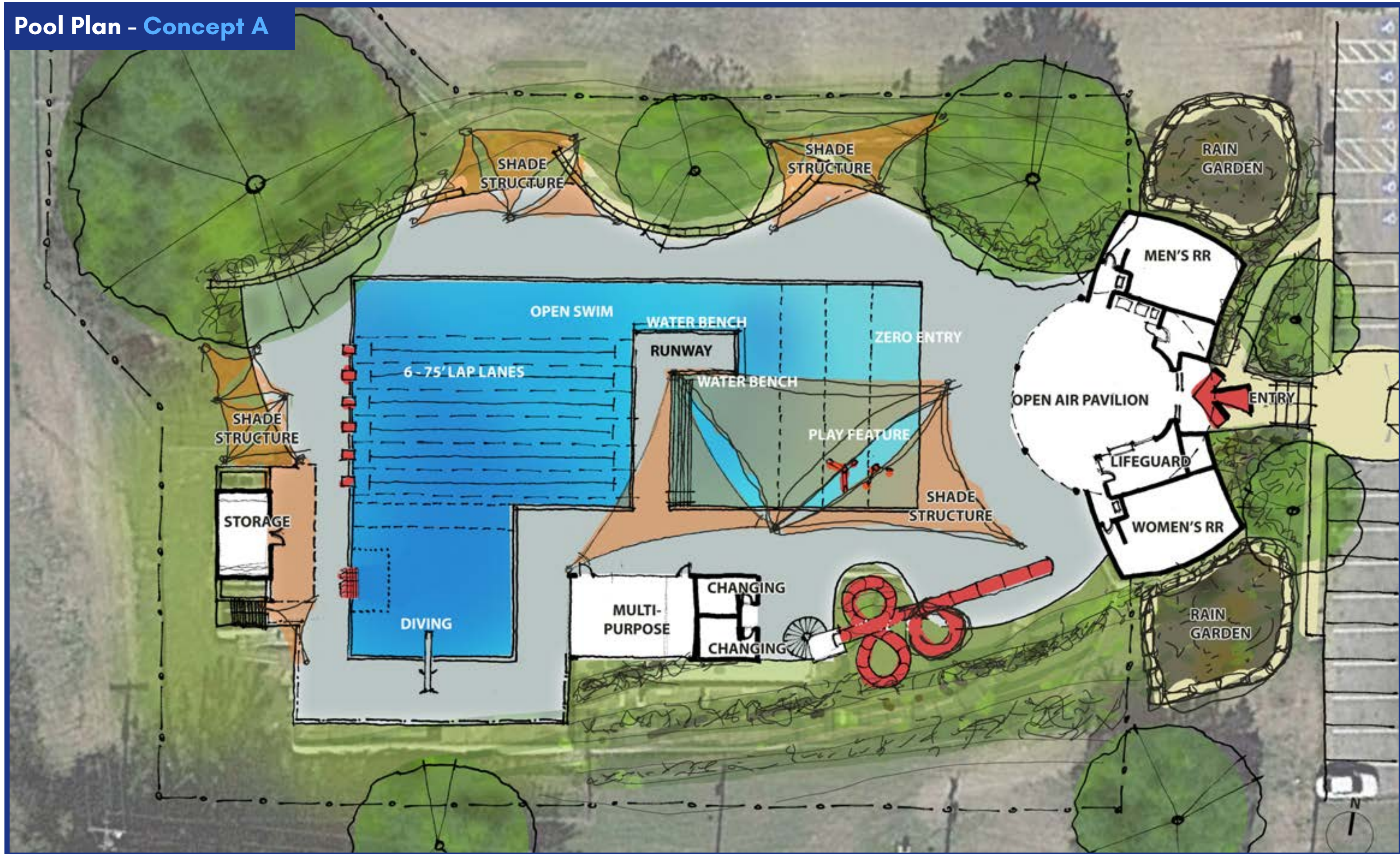

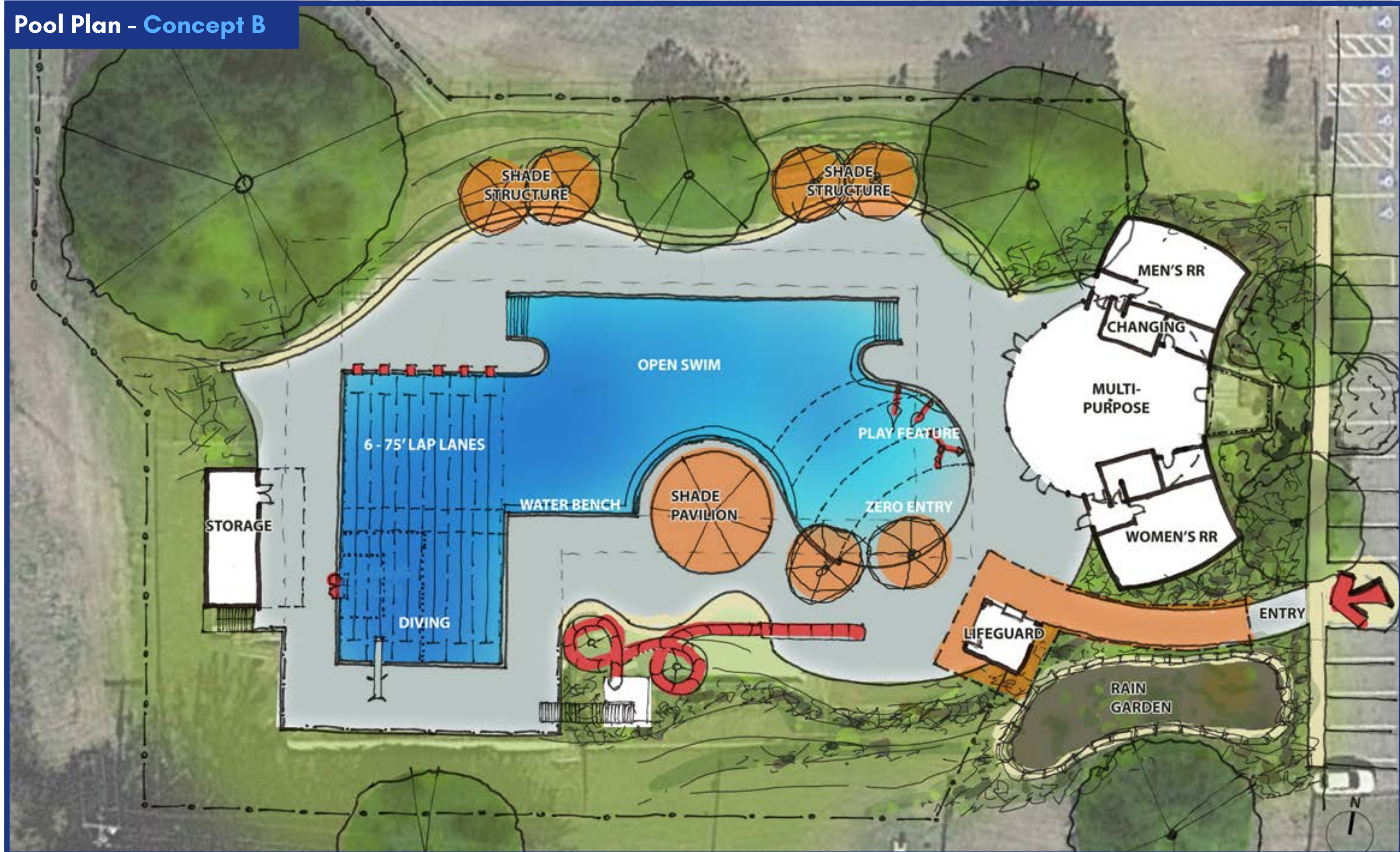

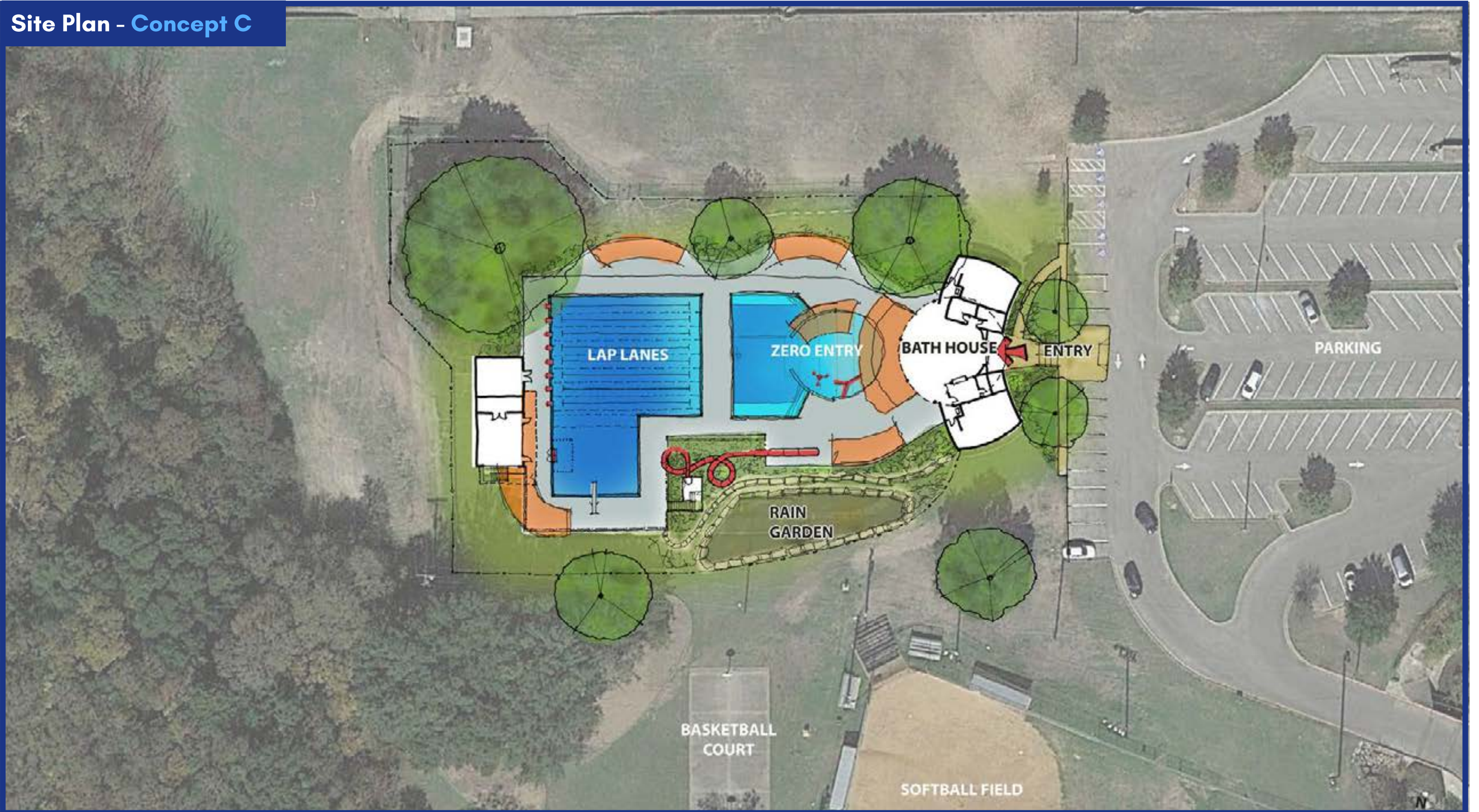
Site Plan - Concept C

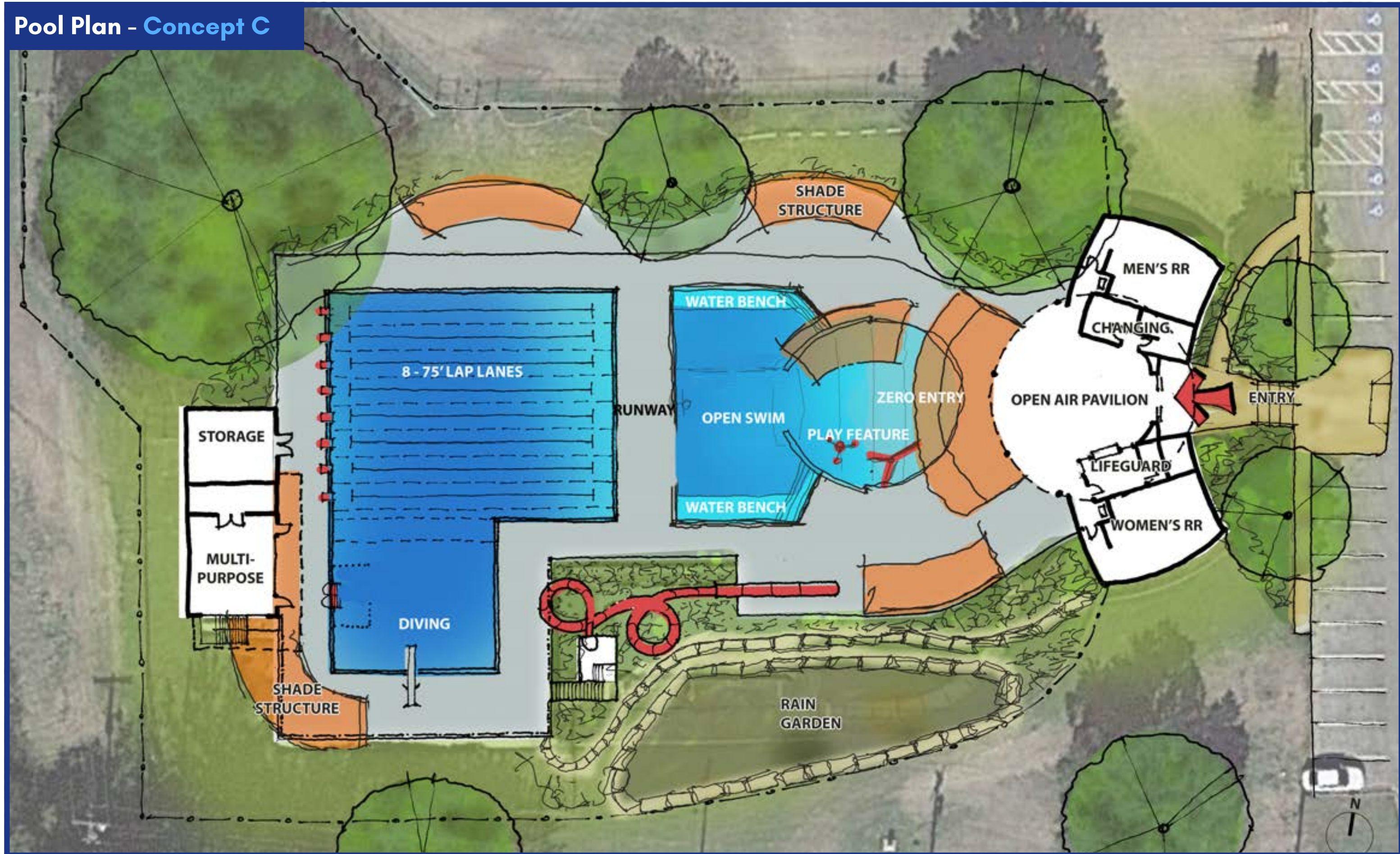
Site Plan - Concept C

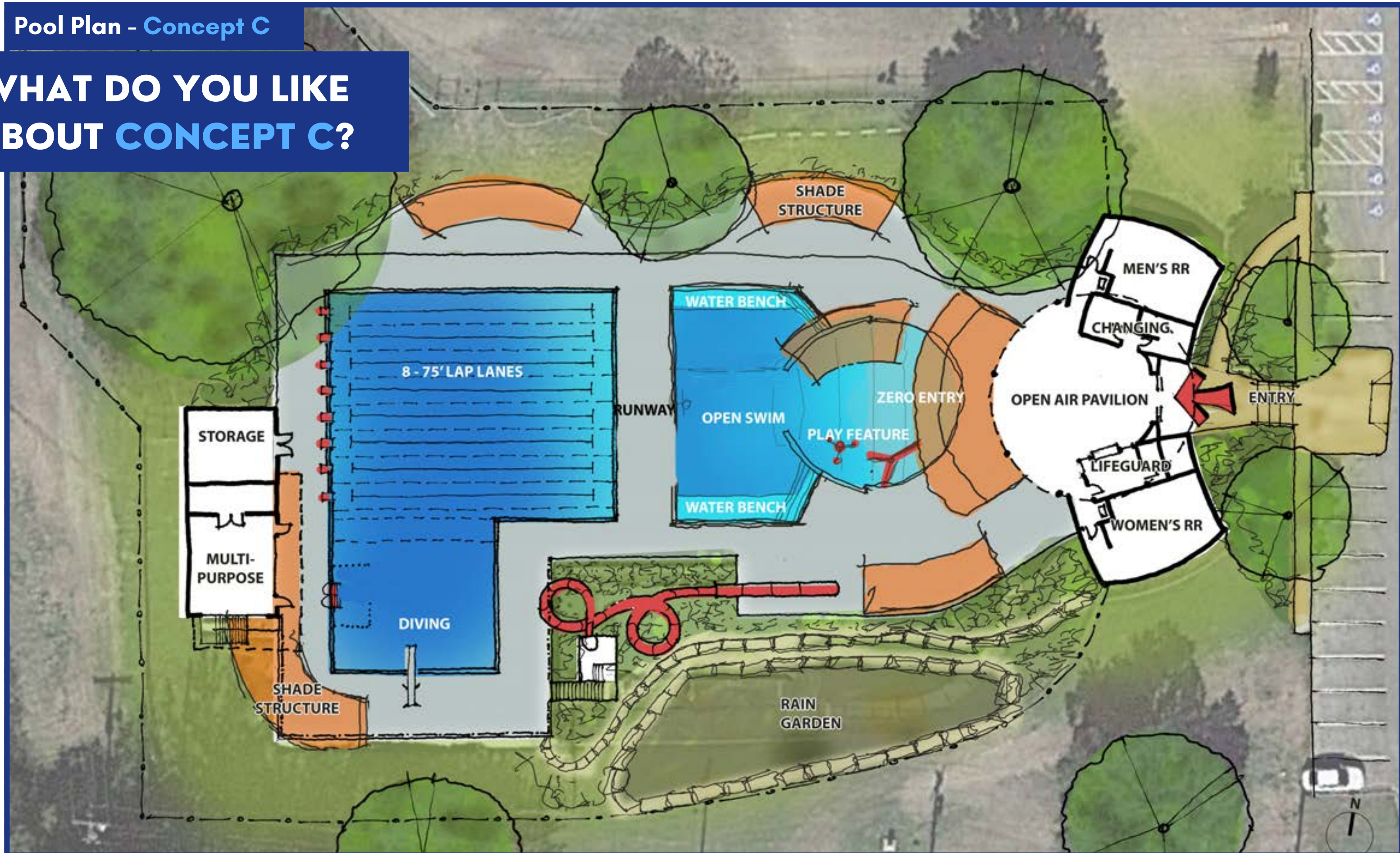
