- 18:47:06 From Sharon Weintraub: Under Section 713.011 (Maintenance Of Municipal Cemeteries), Texas Health and Safety Code, a municipality that operates or has jurisdiction over a public cemetery must maintain the cemetery in a condition that does not endanger the public health, safety, comfort, or welfare. This includes:
- (b) A municipality's responsibility to maintain a cemetery under this section includes:
- (1) repairing and maintaining any fences, walls, buildings, roads, or other improvements;
- (2) leveling or straightening markers or memorial;
- (3) properly maintaining lawns, shrubbery, and other plants;
- (4) removing debris, including dead flowers and deteriorated plastic ornaments; and

- (5) promptly restoring gravesites following an interment.
