202 Firearm Discharge Situations

202.3 DEFINITIONS

Firearm – For the purposes of this policy, a firearm is any device designed, made, or adapted to expel a projectile through a barrel by using the energy generated by an explosion or burning substance or any device readily convertible to that use (e.g., handgun, rifle, shotgun, ~~less lethal shotgun~~). For the purposes of this General Order, TASER Conducted Energy Weapons and less lethal weapons firing kinetic energy projectiles (i.e., less lethal shotguns, 37mm, and 40mm launchers) are not considered firearms.
